JUBILEE PARK NORTH

This area is the highest part of the park, and has the benefit of a rolling landscape, long views looking south, and Colemans' Kitchen Wood, a much loved parcel of ancient woodland.

The aim is to increase biodiversity, by replacing lost hedgerows, planting trees and creating meadows, to provide ecological corridors across the park, linking with Colemans' Kitchen Wood. This will be balanced with improved recreational access, by providing a network of grass and surfaced paths, with fencing, seating, signage, artwork and opportunities for informal play.

The designs include significant tree planting, hedgerow and meadow creation, a shallow wet pond feature, a wide surfaced multi-use path with a main entrance opposite Singleton Environment Centre.

The long views looking south will be retained and framed with planting.
